Junior Jubilee Kids Fishing Rodeo Rules

- Only Mississippi Residents may enter.
- Fish can ONLY be caught in Mississippi Waters south of I-10.
- All winning fish will be determined by weight within slot.
- An angler may only win in one category he or she will choose which category to win the other anglers will move up accordingly.
- Only weights indicated by the digital graduation on the scale will be accepted. Visual fractionalization of these graduations is not allowed.
- If a tie occurs the fish weighed first will be declared the winner. If weigh in times are identical the participant who registered for the tournament will first be declared the winner.
- All fish entering the competition must have been caught by the participant and must be at a designated official way station as soon as possible after landing to preserve their integrity.
- Participants wishing to enter fish in the tournament must be registered before presenting the fish and must sign the official weigh-in form before being entered in the contest.
- They will only need to present their name and registering email address.
- No frozen, spoiled, gutted, altered, or mutilated fish will be eligible for entry.
- For ages 3 to 6 assistance will be allowed for all phases of fishing and catching, for ages 7 to 15, anglers must hook and land fish with no assistance

Note to Parents: Please be considerate of all our volunteer weigh stations and understand that they are not compensated in any way; they are giving their time and resources to assist the Coastal Conservation Association Mississippi in ensuring a fair and sporting event for our young anglers. They are business owners with responsibilities to their customers first, and you may have to wait for a short period.
